

New CBSE Attendance rules 2008

As you are aware that as per Examination Bye-laws of the Board, it is essential for every student to complete 75% of attendances counted from the opening of Class X/XII upto the first of the month preceding the month in which the examination commences. The students who have not completed a regular course of study i.e. have not completed 75% of attendance in Class X/XII are not eligible to appear for the Board's Examination of Class X/XII.

Given below is the relevant extract of Rule 13.2 of the Examination Bye-laws

No student from a School affiliated to the Board shall be eligible to take the examination unless he has completed 75% of attendances counted from the opening of class IX/X/XI/XII upto the first of the month preceding the month in which the examination commences in the subjects of internal assessment.
